Contractor's Commitment Privacy Policy

BuildingGreen ("we," "us," or "our") may ask you, as a signatory of the Contractor's Commitment, to provide personally identifiable or nonpublic information in connection with the reporting requirement for committed companies. This Policy ("Policy") governs how we use or disclose that information.

By becoming a signatory to the Contractor's Commitment, you acknowledge and agree to accept this Policy, which we may amend at any time. If we update this Policy, we will notify all signatories via the email addresses we have on file.

I. TYPES OF INFORMATION WE COLLECT

We may collect personally identifiable information or nonpublic information. Personally identifiable information (or personal information) is information that personally identifies you, such as your name, telephone number, postal address, and email address (or other information that is associated by us with such information). Nonpublic information is information concerning a party's business, methods, policies, or pricing that should not be generally made available to the public. Information can be collected if you submit it to us or it may be collected through technology.

For instance, as a signatory to the Contractor's Commitment, you will be asked to select a number of projects and provide information such as: project location; project revenue; and other relevant information. You will also be asked to aggregate information about construction practices across that portfolio of projects.

II. HOW WE MAY USE IT

We will collect, store, and use this information to assess the impact of the program. We may use certain personal information we collect about you to provide services to you, to fulfill obligations to you under agreements, or to send you administrative communications either about your interactions with us or about features of the Contractor's Commitment, including any future changes to this Policy.



Appropriate safeguards will be put in place to protect personally identifiable and nonpublic information, including restricting access to the system on which the information is stored and encrypting information where appropriate.

III. WHAT WE DISCLOSE

We will never disclose your personal information to any third party for sales or marketing purposes. Subject to the conditions below, we will also never publicly disclose information that could lead to individual projects being identified or that could be attributed to a specific company without your consent. We will only share aggregated information across the program with the public (e.g. total tons of C&D waste diverted from the landfill from all committed companies).

We may disclose your personal information or nonpublic information to our affiliates and other entities and individuals we engage to perform functions on our behalf, or we may disclose certain information if you consent to such disclosure. Some of these entities and individuals may include technology and other consultants, attorneys, accountants, clerical staff, website or database hosting companies, analytics companies, and e-commerce providers. These entities and individuals will have access to your personal information to the extent necessary to perform services on our behalf.

We may also disclose your personal information if legally required to do so, or if we believe in good faith that such action is necessary to conform to legal requirements, comply with legal process, or protect the rights or property of BuildingGreen.

We may also disclose and transfer your personal information to a third party who acquires any or all of our assets, whether by way of acquisition, merger, consolidation, or purchase of all or a substantial portion of our assets. In addition, in the event BuildingGreen becomes the subject of an insolvency proceeding, whether voluntary or involuntary, BuildingGreen or its liquidator, administrator, receiver or administrative receiver may sell, license, or otherwise dispose of such information in a transaction approved by the court.

IV. YOUR RIGHTS; INFORMATION REQUESTS

Subject to applicable law, you have the right to request access to and correct personal information we maintain about you, to request the restriction of processing of your personal information, or to object to that processing on grounds relating to your particular situation. In addition, you may have the right to request erasure of your personal information in certain circumstances provided by applicable law. Please note that if you exercise any of these rights under applicable laws, in order to verify your identity, we may request you provide us with personal information prior to accessing any records containing information about you.
