





What market sector(s) do you specialize in?






How do YOU feel about sustainable design?






Does your firm have a sustainability plan or climate action plan?

Do you make it a regular practice to discuss environmental impacts of decisions with clients (per AIA Code of Ethics)?







Do you have an educational or training plan that includes sustainability issues?



Do you have a plan that requires or rewards employees for getting sustainability accreditations, such as LEED-AP, WELL-AP, etc.?










